ABSTRACT: Sustainable development in the mining industry has now become established practice. Mining companies have realized that without following procedures that consider not only economic gain, but also social and environmental considerations and paying attention to governance, the companies do not have long-term prospects for acquiring and developing new mineral deposits. Firms operating in Arizona are no different and cognizant of the same problems. Unfortunately, public memory, aided by the media, dwells on legacy problems that have existed for decades.
